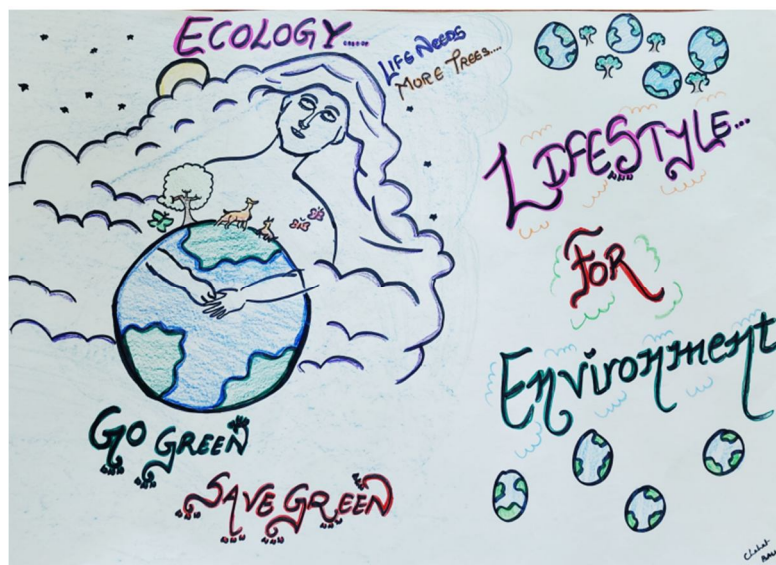


Yuvamanthan Mission India @ 2024

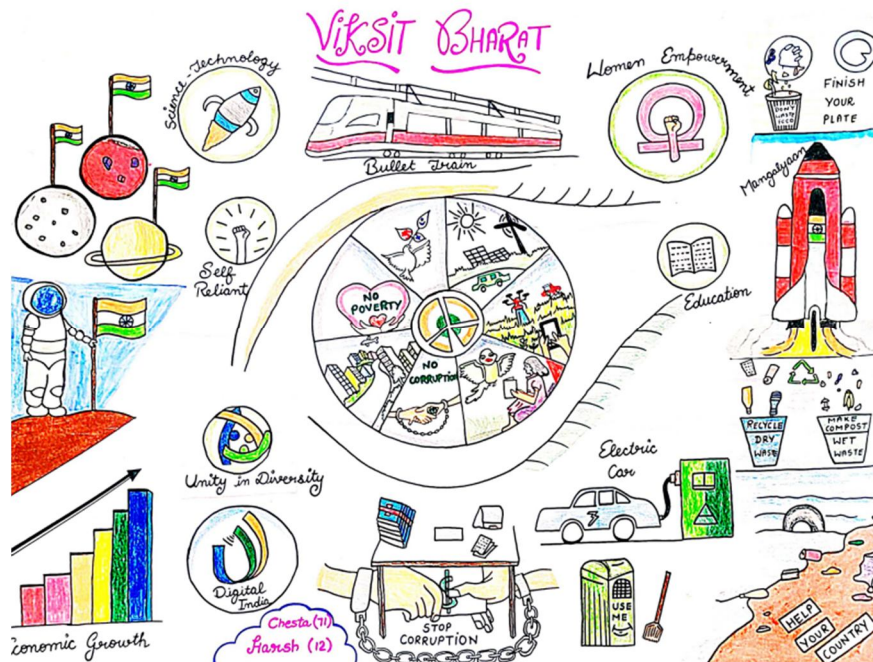
