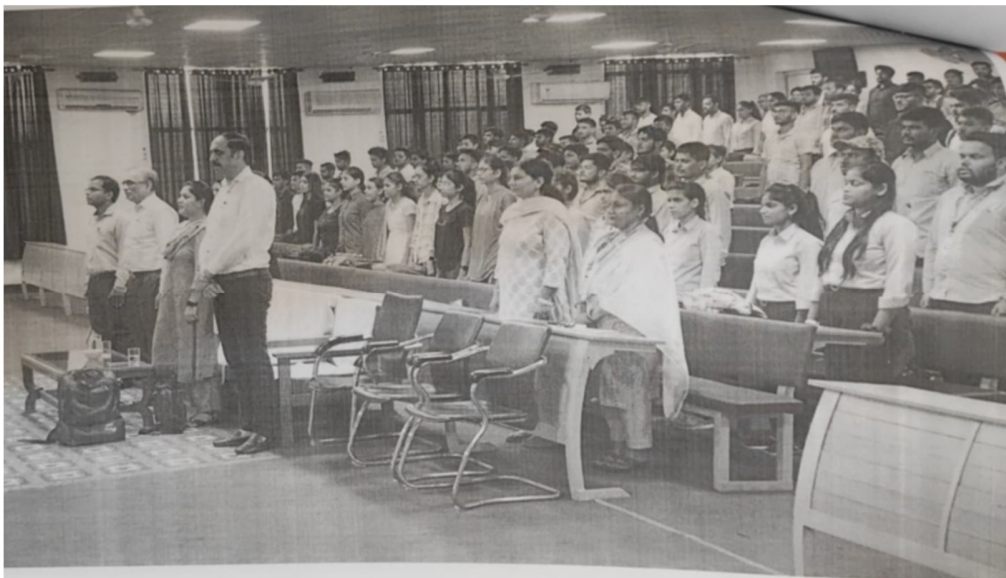


Investor Awareness Program on Financial Empowerment through Wealth Creation
