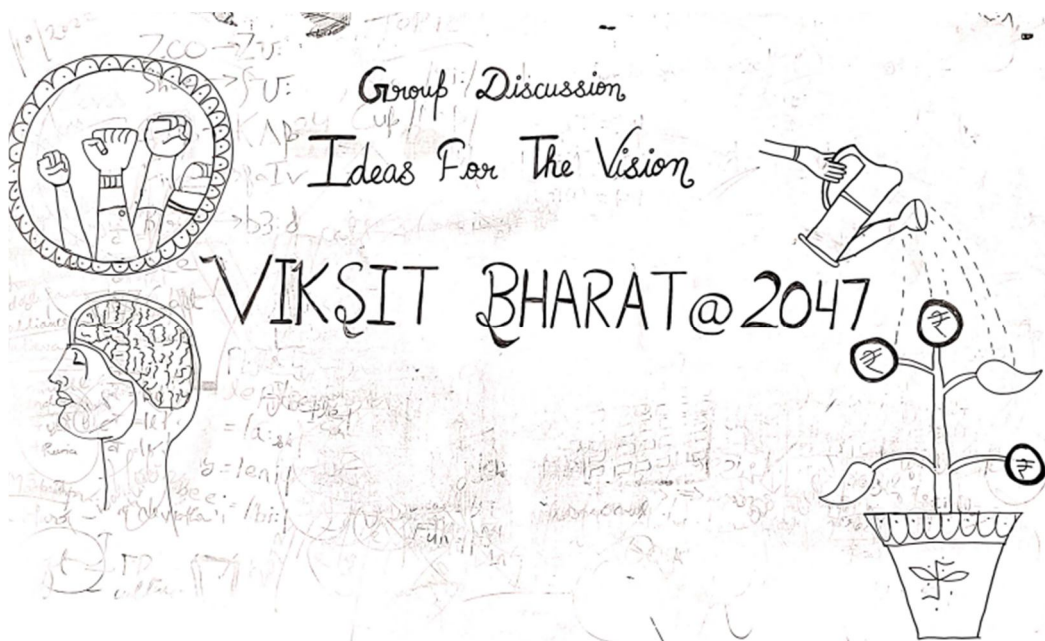


## Group Discussion on “Viksit Bharat @ 2047: Voice of Youth”
