MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

Solid Waste Management

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made and entered into on this 27th day of May, 2025 by and between:

PARTIES TO THE MoU

1. **AARA SCRAP SHERA PRIVATE LIMITED**, a company incorporated under the Companies Act, 2013, having its registered office at Rohtak, Haryana – 124001, India, hereinafter referred to as "**ASS PVT. LTD.**", which is engaged in providing integrated solid waste management solutions, including collection, segregation, transportation, recycling, processing, and scientific disposal of solid waste.

AND

2. **BABA MASTNATH UNIVERSITY**, a duly recognized and accredited private university established under the Haryana Private Universities Act, 2006, located at Asthal Bohar, Rohtak – 124021, Haryana, India, hereinafter referred to as "**BMU**", committed to providing quality education, research, and sustainable development practices across its campus and beyond.


PREAMBLE

Recognizing the importance of sustainable and scientific approaches to environmental management, this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into by and between **Aara Scrap Shera Private Limited** (ASS Pvt. Ltd.) and **Baba Mastnath University (BMU), Asthal Bohar**, to establish a strategic partnership in the domain of **solid waste management**. **Baba Mastnath University (BMU), Asthal Bohar**, is a leading institution of higher education in North India, established and run by the revered **Baba Mastnath Math, Rohtak**. The University is committed not only to academic excellence and holistic development but also to upholding its social and environmental responsibilities. The institution is highly passionate and proactive in managing solid waste at the source, with the objective of ensuring a **clean, green, and sustainable campus environment** in alignment with national and global ecological goals. In this context, the collaboration with ASS Pvt. Ltd. aims to implement a scientifically designed, eco-conscious, and educationally enriching solid waste management system within the BMU campus. The initiative seeks to promote sustainable practices, build awareness among students and staff, and contribute meaningfully to the circular economy and environmental stewardship.

OBJECTIVES

The primary objectives of this MoU are:

- To develop and implement a comprehensive and sustainable solid waste management system at BMU.
- To foster environmental awareness and sustainable behaviour among students, faculty, and staff.
- To promote research, training, and academic collaboration in the field of waste management and environmental sciences.
- To contribute towards the larger goals of the **Swachh Bharat Mission**, the **UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)**, and **Circular Economy practices** in higher education institutions.



SCOPE OF COLLABORATION

The Parties agree to collaborate on the following broad areas:

1. Solid Waste Audit and Planning

- Conducting an initial assessment of the university's waste generation, types, and current disposal methods.
- Designing a tailored Solid Waste/ scrap Management (SWM) plan based on the audit findings.

2. Waste Collection and Segregation Mechanisms

- Installation of color-coded bins and signage for proper source segregation (organic, recyclable, and inert waste).
- Provision of trained personnel for collection and daily waste handling.

3. Processing, Recycling, and Disposal

- Installation of composting units for organic waste management.
- Channelizing recyclable waste to authorized recycling centers.
- Scientific and environmentally compliant disposal of non-recyclable waste.

4. Awareness and Capacity Building

- Organizing workshops, seminars, awareness drives, and green campus campaigns.
- Creating educational content and training modules for students and staff.

5. Internships and Research Support

- Offering internship opportunities for BMU students in environmental sciences and related fields.
- Supporting joint research publications, project proposals, and technical papers on waste management innovations.


6. Monitoring, Evaluation, and Reporting

- Regular tracking of waste volumes, segregation efficiency, and environmental impact.
- Submission of quarterly progress reports to the BMU administration.

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

ASS PVT. LTD. Shall:

- Provide all required technical support, equipment, manpower, and logistics for implementation of the SWM plan.



- Ensure compliance with the Municipal Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 and other relevant regulatory frameworks.
- Offer internship, training, and industry exposure to students of BMU.
- Maintain transparency in all waste handling, disposal, and reporting activities.

BMU Shall:

- Provide necessary infrastructure, space, and facilities for setting up waste segregation, collection, and composting units.
- Appoint a dedicated nodal officer to coordinate the project implementation and communication with ASS Pvt. Ltd.
- Integrate sustainability and environmental management topics into its academic and extracurricular activities.
- Extend full cooperation and participation of university departments, students, and staff in this initiative.

FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENT

The detailed financial terms including the cost of services, equipment, and operations shall be finalized through separate **Service Level Agreements (SLA)** or **Work Orders**, duly approved and signed by authorized representatives of both Parties for the solid waste/scrap. Cost-sharing models, if any, shall be mutually agreed upon in writing.

DURATION AND VALIDITY

This MoU shall remain valid for a period of **one (1) years** from the date of signing and may be extended or renewed upon mutual consent of the Parties in writing.

Either Party may terminate this MoU by providing **at least thirty (30) days prior written notice**, specifying valid reasons. Upon termination, all outstanding obligations shall be settled amicably.

CONFIDENTIALITY


The Parties agree to maintain confidentiality of proprietary and sensitive information shared during the term of this MoU, unless disclosure is required under law or with prior written consent.

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS (IPR)

Any research findings, innovations, or intellectual property arising from joint projects will be jointly owned and managed as per mutually agreed terms outlined in subsequent agreements.

DISPUTE RESOLUTION

Any dispute or difference arising out of or relating to this MoU shall be resolved amicably through mutual consultation. If the dispute remains unresolved, it shall be referred to a sole



arbitrator mutually appointed by the Parties under the provisions of the **Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996**. The venue of arbitration shall be **Rohtak, Haryana**.

GOVERNING LAW AND JURISDICTION

This MoU shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India. The courts at Rohtak, Haryana shall have exclusive jurisdiction.


